Working with allies across the country, we're mobilizing advocates in 35 states and taking on issues suppressed by corporate power. Today, we're expanding our reach to influence federal legislation and build a united movement to stop these programs nationwide.



When the World Looks Back, We Look Ahead

The Global Wellness Forum's mission isn't to repair a broken past—it's to build the future we already know is possible.

Much of the modern world is oriented toward retrospection. Governments pour over old data, industries cling to established systems, and public discourse loops endlessly through yesterday's crises. This backward gaze can feel safe it offers the illusion of certainty, the comfort of familiarity. But it also has a cost: it binds our energy to the past, and leaves little room to imagine what lies ahead.

Psychologists have long observed that where attention goes, energy follows. A society consumed by revisiting its wounds inevitably prolongs them. Forward movement requires a different posture—one that sees possibility before it is proven, and invests in structures that don't yet exist. This is not naïve optimism; it's a discipline. It is the practice of holding a clear vision of what's possible and working deliberately to bring it into being. For the first time ever, public opinion, policymakers, and the legal system are now aligning in our favor. We must stay in the present, while simultaneously building the future.


The Impact

Florida Becomes First State to Criminalize Geoengineering

Florida has become the first state in the nation to criminalize geoengineering and weather modification, passing legislation that will carry felony penalties of up to five years in prison for offenders. The new law also mandates that airports report suspicious aerial activities, with enforcement provisions taking effect October 1, 2025.

The Global Wellness Forum played a pivotal role in advancing this legislation. From the bill's first hearing to the final vote, GWF mobilized the state of Florida in support of the bill. Marla Maples, Aimee Villella McBride, and Jacquie Jordan testified at the bill's first hearing. Aimee then went on to testify at two additional hearings and spoke on the Capitol steps during a statewide MAHA Advocacy Lobbying Day, helping revive the bill when it was stalled and close to dying. The work for GWF drew national attention and energized grassroots supporters.

Behind the scenes, GWF coordinated a massive public outreach effort in partnership with Stand for Health Freedom, resulting in nearly 100,000 emails to state legislators. These citizen voices, combined with the on-the-ground testimony of advocates and experts, helped break through political gridlock when the bill appeared stalled.



This wasn't just a policy win-it was a signal to the rest of the country that citizens can set the terms for what happens in our **skies**, says Aimee Villella McBride.

The win in Florida built massive momentum as 35 states now have similar legislation proposed. GWF has been instrumental in providing legislative and policy guidance, strategy support at both the state and federal level. Now, with a grassroots toolkit in development to further propel progress, plus impacting policy at the federal level by shaping the new Clear Skies Act recently introduced in Congress by Rep. Marjorie Taylor Greene, GWF is working at the local, state and national level on this issue.

Beyond the legal precedent, this victory represents a broader assertion of environmental sovereignty—a statement that public health, environmental integrity, and transparency take precedence over covert experimentation and corporate agendas. For GWF, Florida's new law is both a milestone and a launchpad, marking the beginning of a coordinated national movement.



Where It's Most at Risk

How GWF's Ban ECT Initiative Targets Harm Hidden in Plain Sight

At GWF, protecting life means confronting dangers others overlook — especially those harming the most vulnerable. Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) is one of them. Performed daily in U.S. hospitals and clinics, it sends up to 460 volts through the brain to induce a full cerebral seizure. While promoted as treatment for severe depression, bipolar disorder and catatonia ECT's is known to cause permanent memory loss, brain injury, cardiac events, and even death in some patients.

Never tested under modern FDA safety standards, ECT devices bypassed regulation in 1976 and were later downgraded to "moderate risk" (Class II medical device) despite decades of evidence to the contrary. Courts have already held manufacturers liable for failing to warn patients of severe adverse effects, yet the practice continues — often without true informed consent and with wasteful taxpayer funding.

"The right to health includes the right to be free from treatments that cause harm," says GWF co-founder Sayer Ji. "Ending ECT is part of building a medical future that truly heals."

For GWF, this is not a fringe debate but a human rights crisis. Through our Council on Psych Rights & Trauma-Informed Care, we aim to end coercive, harmful, and unethical medical practices. Banning ECT is part of our broader mission: uncover hidden harm, confront it with science, law, and advocacy, and ensure care never comes at the cost of humanity. ECT is another example of regulatory capture, deceptive science, and a system putting profit over people. ECT represents the ultimate violation of informed consent and human dignity.

HR 4668, restoring the public's right to hold pharmaceutical companies accountable, has returned to Congress.
